

INFOS REGARDING EVS IN THE PRINCIPALITY OF MONACO

OVERVIEW OF THE MONEGASQUE SITUATION

To encourage switching to electric automobiles, the Principality offers about 300 electric car charging stations free of charge. For the hybrid engines, one recharge guarantees a range of 40-50 km, equivalent in fuel to 10 euros (dkk 74,52) saved. For the electric cars, a range of 200-300 km saves around 50-60 euros (dkk 372,59/ 447,11). The parking rate goes down by 20 euros a month for those drivers with electric vehicles who subscribe to Monaco Parkings. The national Monaco statistics bureau, IMSEE, reports that in 2017 the number of electric cars corresponded to 842. This figure has risen to 2572 for the year 2021; as for hybrid engines, they have increased from 867 (2017) to 2606 (in 2021).



THE DISTRIBUTION OF CHARGING UNITS

In the small Principality there are 300 public charging points, offered by the Monegasque government, which are completely free of any type of charge. This choice was made to boost the sales of EVs in the country as well as reduce the environmental impact of the cars circulating on the nation's roads. These charging points can be found all around Monaco, especially in big parking lots, gas stations and the main roads.

THE MOST USED APPS IN THE PRINCIPALITY OF MONACO

1. YOURMONACO



YourMonaco is an app offering services and featuring information about quality of life in Monaco.

You choose the information most relevant to you and add it to your favourites. You'll then find it on the app's homepage every time you open it. There's no need to create an account to start taking advantage of the services that YourMonaco offers, but if what you're looking for is a map with the position of the different charging stations, you'll have to configure the app in order to access that information. The website of the app has a video (french only) explaining how you can do it.

2. CHARGEMAP

Open Charge Map is a non-commercial, non-profit, community-based project of drivers.

This means that while the other apps are owned by a company that earns on roaming charges, Open Charge Map is just a map, albeit very complete, made by its users. This characteristic is very useful to find new columns because this app is updated faster than the others.

3. PLUGSHARE



Plugshare is an app that unifies the networks of different charging operators on a single map. The charging points surveyed are over 300 thousand and the wallet system is an available method of payment.

There are also the classic filters such as selecting the model of the vehicle used and asking the app to show only the columns compatible with it, or those of a certain power or linked to a specific network. Similarly to Chargemap, this app offers a map with an overview of the entire world.

THE MAIN MONEGASQUE OPERATOR

Monaco On: This is the main public monegasque operator, offered by the princely government. Its charging points are spread across the entire Country in different locations such as parking lots, streets and gas stations. Developed starting in 2021 to help the Principality's fight against climate change, it now has 300 charging points in the whole territory.
